### Spiritual Horizons – New in 2020



The Spiritual Horizons Program presents in some depth a number of key themes related to Carmelite spirituality. The Program aims:

• to facilitate our personal spiritual journey by exploring specifically Carmelite topics;

• to provide practical ways of engaging in a personal discernment process throughout; and to contribute to building a community around Carmelite spirituality.

Beginning with an introductory session in February to assist in the process of personal discernment throughout the program, it offers four lots of two-week sessions on Thursday afternoons in March, May, July, October. Topics, dates, times and presenters are listed in this program and on the website under Events.

Growing out of the 2019 Symposium on Ways of Seeing is a program of seven Creative Spirituality Workshops.

Details of each workshop are on the website. It is advised to book early as numbers are limited.

Chanting with Susan Frykberg. Old and new Christian chants. No musical ability required, nor prior experience in chanting. Begins with four Saturdays in February. Later dates to be advised on the website.

Art-Journaling with Pam Cox. Art-journaling practice, learning to see and record your life as a work of art. Six fortnightly sessions, Tuesdays February to April.

Poetry with Philip Harvey. Reading and writing poetry, working through different aspects of the spiritual life. Ten sessions, 2nd Tuesday of month February to November.

Iconography with Rob Gallacher. The aim is to paint an icon of Christ Pantocrator in ten sessions over two weekends in May.

Calligraphy with Sally Diserio. Introduction to the use of a broad edged nib followed by the study of classical calligraphy alphabets, i.e. the foundational hand and the uncial hand. Six sessions May to July.

Mandala with Michele Harris. Art making as a spiritual journey utilising mandala as the conduit. Four sessions in the second half of the year. Dates to be advised.

#### The Spirit in Movement with Suzanne Fermanis.

Movement prayer classes, which will include relaxation and yoga-based exercises. Four sessions in the second half of the year. Dates to be advised.


